## JUNE MEETING

\*\*\* Twice, our June speaker, Thomas F. Coleman, Attorney and Counselor at Law, has represented Parents FLAG successfully, before the United States Supreme Court, within the past two years. Last year attorney Coleman was appointed by John Van De Kamp, the Attorney General of California, to the Commission on Racial, Ethnic, Religious and Minority Violence. During the Brown Administration, Coleman served as Executive Director of the Governor's Commission on Personal Privacy. Coleman has been in the forefront in the fight against discrimination against Gays. Now a recent Court of Appeals decision has upheld employment benefits discrimination against gay employees and their domestic partners. Because of the activity of Parents FLAG in such matters, Coleman will discuss this latest action and outline how to program a response. The topic of discussion will be "Let's End Discrimination Against Gay Couples". Attorney Coleman will answer any questions about the cases mentioned. This will be an opportunity to gain insight into one of the top problems with which our children must contend.
